It is supplied with electricity and piped water. There are 42 houses on the telephone, and 4 T.V. sets. 64 people own cars. Daily bus service into Diss for workers. 3 ~~buses~~ <sup>different services</sup> run on Friday (Market Day) 3 village shops. Village schoolmaster is Mr H. Pascoe, also chairman of Village Hall Committee, who opened a new hall (a converted South Norfolk Barn) last month (February).
