## Bressingham and Fersfield Parish Council

### Minutes of the Meeting held on the 1<sup>st</sup> of August 2016

The meeting opened at 7.00 p.m .

#### **Present**

Councillors – Chair, Mr R Hewitt, Mr K Traynier, Mr D Hodges, Mr J Kemp, Mrs A Lawson, Mr D Neville and Mr R Spall. Also present were Ms M Lanchester, representing SpeedWatch, and the clerk Mr M Mortimer.

#### **2 Declaration of Interests**

Mrs Lawson declared an interest in item 5 - planning

#### **3 To agree the minutes of the 4<sup>th</sup> of July 2016**

The minutes were agreed

#### **4 Matters arising from the minutes**

Mr Hewitt thanked Mr Kemp for attending the licensing meeting regarding Bressingham Hall. Mr Kemp reported that the licence had been given. The sale of alcohol was to end at 11.30 and finish time midnight.

Mr Hewitt reported that the Church Meadow Committee was being reconstituted.

He explained that he had made a reference to the Carer's Card on the website and that the manager of Hall Farm had agreed to look at the problem of water running off the fields onto The Street in Fersfield.

Mr Traynier agreed to liaise with the village sign makers about the post.

Mr Hewitt explained that he had made contact with somebody about the condition of the post boxes who agreed to investigate.

#### **5 Planning**

Approval was recommended for the development at Harvest House on the A1066 and for Stone Lane Farm and Stone Lane Barn. Mr Traynier agreed to look at 72 Common Road and report to the clerk.

#### **6 Any other matters**

Mr Kemp raised the matter of plans to help those alone at Christmas. Mr Hewitt explained that the churches were considering what to do and that he would keep Mr Kemp informed.

Mr Hewitt reported that new moveable speed signs had been installed in Fersfield and would shortly be moved to Bressingham. Several councillors reported positive responses from residents. Mr Traynier explained the various displays on the signs and pointed out that the batteries would need recharging regularly and that arrangement needed to be made as to where that should be and about payment for electricity.

Mr Hewitt asked Ms Lanchester for her reaction to the signs. She expressed disappointment that the SpeedWatch team hadn't been consulted and explained that it was her understanding that the use of the mobile SAM signs operated by SpeedWatch would not be allowed now the new signs were in place. Mr Hewitt said that he, Ms Lanchester, Mr Traynier and the clerk should get together to discuss the issue.

Mr Spall pointed out that some existing 30mph signs were obscured by hedges and Mr Hewitt agreed to contact Highways.
