There was a complaint that the PC had not submitted a response to the National Grid Pylon consultation. That work by County Broadband and other utilities in Common Road had been disruptive and unsatisfactory were further complaints along with the condition of some footpath bridges.

Mr Easter reported that nutrient neutrality rules had been relaxed meaning that the Long Stratton bypass and associated new housing could be started soon.
