

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (STRO13080) affecting the A1066 High Road from its junction with U76073 Hall Lane for 2500m westwards (the "Road") in the Parish of Bressingham and Fersfield to facilitate surface dressing works, the Road will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access) for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be from 8th to 22nd August 2025, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 3rd October 2025 where the closure is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

NB: These works will be carried out in 3 phases. Phase 1 will be between 19:00 and 05:00 from 8th to 10th August. Phase 2 will be between 19:00 and 05:00 from 12th to 14th August. Phase 3 will be between 19:00 and 05:00 from 20th to 22nd August.

Alternative route is via: High Road, Low Road, Diss Road, The Street, Thetford Road, Church Road, Euston Road, Fakenham Road, Barnham Road, Fakenham Hill, Ixworth Road, A1088, Bardwell Road, A143 Stanton Road, Bury Road, Snape Hill, Mill Road, A143, A140, Victoria Road, Park Road, Stanley Road (Bressingham, Ixworth Thorpe, Riddlesworth, Fakenham Magna, Roydon, Diss, Stanton, Ixworth, Hepworth, Rickingham Superior, Honington, South Lopham, Garboldisham, Stuston, Botesdale, Palgrave, Brettenham, Rickingham Inferior, Scole, Burgate, Wortham, Euston, Wattisfield, Harling, Bardwell, Thrandeston).

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Norfolk County Council.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Road where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 3rd October 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

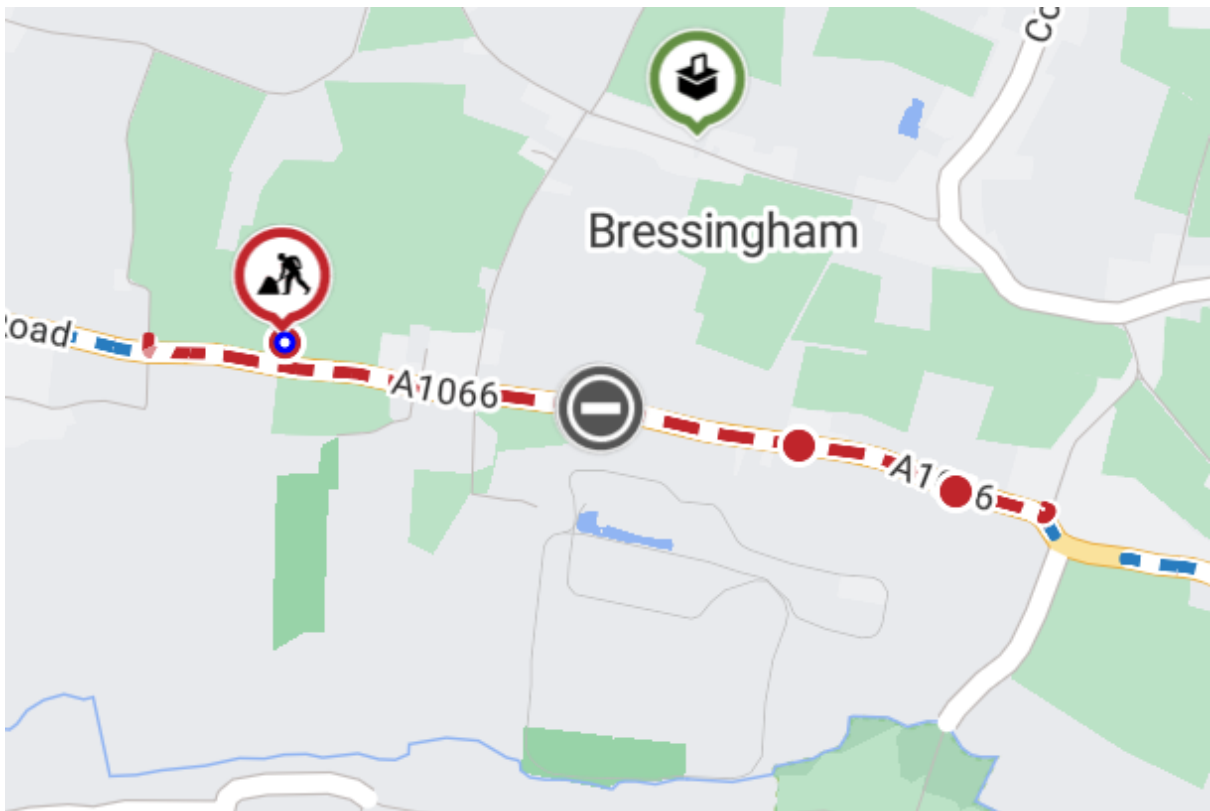
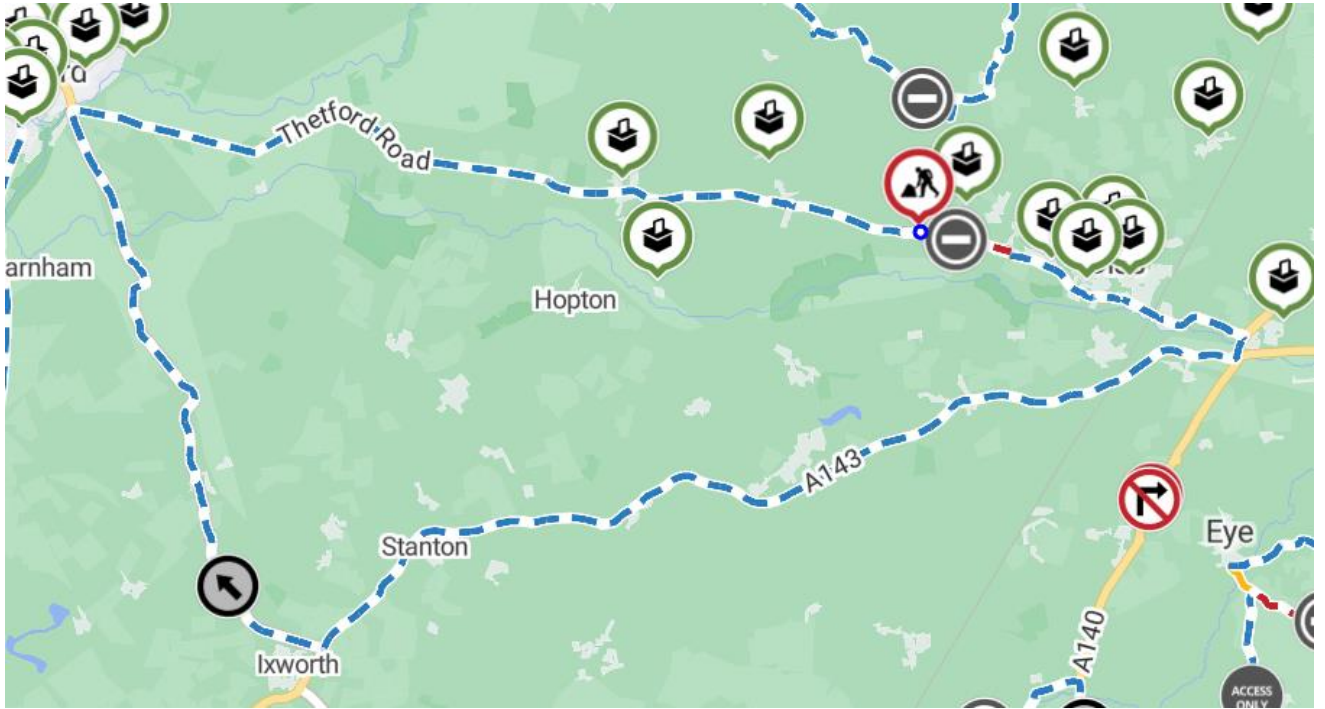
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
